This bold, bright chime is tuned to its namesake melody, *Morning Mood* from Edward Greig's Peer Gynt Suite #1, Opus 46. The melody is a musical palindrome; it's the same whether played backwards or forwards. As a result the melody is recreated on the Morning Mood Chime, no matter what direction the clapper is rotated. Suggested retail price \$59.99. Also available in Ocean Blue.

Enchanting and magical, the Woodstock Mystic Chime gets its wonderfully eclectic tuning from the whole tone scale used by Claude Debussy and other impressionist composers. The 23" **Woodstock Mystic Chime™** (*pictured on the enclosed CD – ID: MYL*) features thirteen ½" black powder-coated tubes and is accented with tiny black beads and cherry finished wood. This chime can be used both indoors and outdoors to create a veiled mood of mystery. Suggested retail price \$29.99.

Also debuting this summer, the **Woodstock Passport Chime™ - Bali** (*pictured on the enclosed CD – ID: PCBS*), is hand-tuned to a traditional Balinese scale.
